Extended Access: The practice has Extended Access appointments and available to our patients via our partnership with the Hinckley and Bosworth Federation. These appointments are available outside of our core hours, which are after 6.30pm and on a Saturdays.

Pharmacy First Scheme: Please remember that a lot of appropriate issues you have like hay fever, (UTIs) water infections, etc can be sorted by your local pharmacy, rather than using your GP. We will offer patients one of these appointments if we feel they are appropriate. If you are offered any of the additional appointments, please consider it.

On September 30th with help from our PPG we will be opening our doors to patients for them to come and see what additional services can be accessed through the practice. Services confirmed to attend are The Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council Mental Health and Active Services. Patient Survey 2024:

We have recently received our patient survey details for 2024. Our overall patient satisfaction % is up from 82% to 89% which puts us 12th out of 146 practices in Leicestershire and 756 out of 6307 nationally. We are very pleased with these results, and this is even more impressive given the reduced funding for General Practice and the increased patient list size.
